[Web Site for SCCC is Master of its own Domain](#)

The web site for SCCC is now master of its own domain. The club has acquired www.sccameraclub.org and the site is now located there. Shortly, the old site will be removed, but a pointer will be placed there to link automatically to the new site. Steve Crabb has added a few new links. First, we will have photos online from the "Gallery" button. We are still selecting the best display format, but we hope to have it active by this weekend, March 10. It was intended to be 'live' by now, but was delayed to have an easily changed format that shows our club photos at their best.

The "Newsletters" button provides quick and easy access to past SCCC newsletters. Please note that since September of this year, Carl has sent Adobe Acrobat files, so that formatting and appearance remains the same, and you do not need the original program to view or print. You must have Adobe Acrobat, of course, and a free download is available by using the link on the page. The current newsletter is posted at the top as soon as it becomes available.

The next button is another new item - "Latest News." This button links to a page that Larry set-up by using a site called "Blogger." Although the Blogger site is for web logs, or on-line diaries, this is a very useful and powerful tool for quick postings to a web page without having to code 'html' language. And, any club member that needs to post can be 'invited' which provides that person with immediate publishing to our web page without contacting the web master.

Please click on Latest News and take a look. It will allow immediate postings of events, deadlines, and club information with no delay. If you have need for access, let Larry know and you will be invited to make postings, which provides you with your own password to the page. This week the year-end requirements were quickly copied and posted for the club members. Please get in the habit of checking here often! And, don't forget to refresh or reload the page if you do check often, as the changes will not show if the page is read from the cache of your browser. As time passes, and the old information is a long way down the page, you may wish to click the 'archive' button which will give you access to the information by month.

The 'Special Events' button remains for major club events or photo happenings. Please feel free to email Larry with information and dates of important club events, but more often than not, the "Latest Events" button is the best place to check first. The "Special" button location will be used for events further into the future or larger events.
