## **CRITICISM**

THE AMERICAN ANNUAL OF PHOTOGRAPHY, 1948

Excerpt from ""The Story of 16 Prints by Frank R. Fraprie  
....."Criticism of a work of art can be administered by a sympathetic and competent master who is instructing his pupil, during the creative stages, but when a work is completed it is not likely to be taken apart and reconstructed, and any searching criticism of it can do little good except as it can be applied in part to future problems. Some criticism of prints, which is so popular a feature of camera club meetings, is done by intelligent and sympathetic workers of ability who undertake the task reluctantly, approach it with humility, and try to find in some of the promising pictures an opportunity to point out gently paths for future improvements. Far more frequently it is done by self-satisfied commentators whose criticism amounts to: Go thou and do like-wise. They have learned that there are rules of composition. The slightest infraction of any so-called rule damns a picture for them. They have yet to learn that the true artists is bound by no rules but his imagination and good taste, and that the position which the principal interest in a picture takes is a matter of balance of all factors, of line, tone, and color, that no mathematical rules of placing are of any importance whatsoever, and that any change in the importance of values or lighting in any area of the print necessitates a rearrangement of all other factors."
