FRAN KINGSBURY GARNERS GOLD

Recently Fran Kingsbury was the winner of a Gold Medal for a print in the 2005 Oklahoma International Exhibition of Photography. When asked for his comments Fran replied:

"Yes, I was awarded the Judge's Choice Gold Medal for a color print titled "Mountain Goat" taken in Banff, Canada, some years ago. The print was also a winner in past SCCC and N4C competitions.

A more interesting part of the story revolves around a black and white print titled "Petunia" that also was accepted in the exhibition. Petunia was a pet skunk raised some 30 years ago. The negative was exposed in the snow and the contrast was not controllable in the conventional darkroom. In recent weeks, the negative was scanned on an Epson 4870 scanner and printed in Photoshop Elements on an Epson Stylus Photo 2200 printer. Some work was done to control the excessive contrast, plus other "refinements" which can only be done in the digital darkroom.

A third print titled "Big Show" was accepted for hanging in the nature division.

Fran also commented on the fact that his very dear friend, Herkimer, is feeling "ignored" with all this digital stuff going on.
