N4C News & Changes from Springbrook

The following news and changes as decided by the N4C board at Springbrook:

- One new digital category has been added: Contemporary.
- No comments will be recorded for digital imaging contests; too many images and it takes too much time.
- N4C will no longer accept matted prints for traditional print competitions
- "Digital matting" is acceptable; the "matte" is part of the image on the same piece of paper.
- Flush mounting of the prints is acceptable as long as the print and mount are within accepted limits for size.
- In other words the mattes do not extend beyond the edges of the print or above the print.
- These changes are the result of postage/shipping increases.
- SCCC will need to decide whether or not we will follow N4C's lead in this. We do not HAVE to. We have traditionally followed their lead to avoid confusion. We will decide at a later date.
