Experience kayaking, rock climbing, shooting, archery, camping, fly fishing, Dutch oven cooking demos and so much more. Over 80 outdoor sporting and nature-related exhibits and vendors. Manufacturer's reps will also be on hand to demonstrate the latest in outdoor sporting equipment and products.

All activities are free to the public and guided hayrack shuttles take you to each event. Plenty of food vendors are on hand to keep you fueled. A Nebraska Park Permit is required for Park entry and is available at the Park entrance. Daily permits are \$4 per vehicle. Annual permits are \$20.
